SMALL PELAGIC FINAL TAC – 2016

Please be advised that the aDDG:Fisheries has approved the FINAL small pelagic TAC's, TAB's and associated PUCL's and pools for 2016 as follows:

Additional:

- 1) Industry associations are requested that Right Holders should spread their combined catching effort of the proportion of the directed >14 cm sardine TAC taken to the West of Cape Agulhas (west of 20° E) and which should not exceed 33 500t
- 2) The pelagic industry (through the Chief Area Controller Mr. Derlé Chambers – 073 5544 288 and derle@oranjevis.co.za) should continue to take appropriate steps to attempt to keep the sardine by-catch as low as possible by avoiding areas where a relatively high proportion of sardine is found

mixed with anchovy schools. Also refer to permit conditions related to horse mackerel management and the necessary communication procedures via the Chief Area Controller.

- 3) Note that St. Croix Island, Ruy Banks and Dassen Island remain closed for 2016. Kindly refer to permit conditions in this regard.
- 4) General - permits:
 - a. Top-Up on current issued initial TAC reflected permits are free, so please indicate the wording "**TOP-UP**" on all original permits which should now be returned to our Customer Services Centre as soon as possible to be amended with new TAC's/TAB's.
 - b. RH's MUST confirm 2015 total catch with JohannesDG@daff.gov.za - confirmed 2015 exceeding (if any) will be deducted on the final 2016 TAC's as per permit conditions.
 - c. Kindly attach a letter of authorisation with proper contact details for "TOP-UP" permit collections.
 - d. Ensure that all applicable vessel licences and SARS certificates are valid when returning these currently issued original initial TAC/TAB permits for anchovy and sardine.
