Fishing Rights Allocation Process

FRAP21/22 PROCESS (Roadmap) **(For Decentralised Support Centres Staff):**

1 November 2021 -

FRAP Online System (URL: <https://frap2021.co.za>) opens for Applicants to REGISTER as Users.

8 November 2021 -

Decentralised Support Centres open. Applicants may visit these Centres for assistance to REGISTER. Note that the opening and closing times of these Centres are critically important.

22 November 2021 -

The FRAP Online System opens for Applicants to APPLY for a fishing right. Applicants may visit the Decentralised Support Centres for assistance to APPLY and SUBMIT their online application and documentation into the System.

7 December 2021 –

FRAP Online System closes at 24:00. Although the Decentralised Support Centres close at 13:00, ALL applicants that are in the queue on the last day, MUST be supported.

NB: Do not complete the REGISTRATION or the SUBMISSION/APPLICATION on behalf of applicants. Their fingers (or the fingers of their authorised representatives) must touch the computer mouse themselves.
