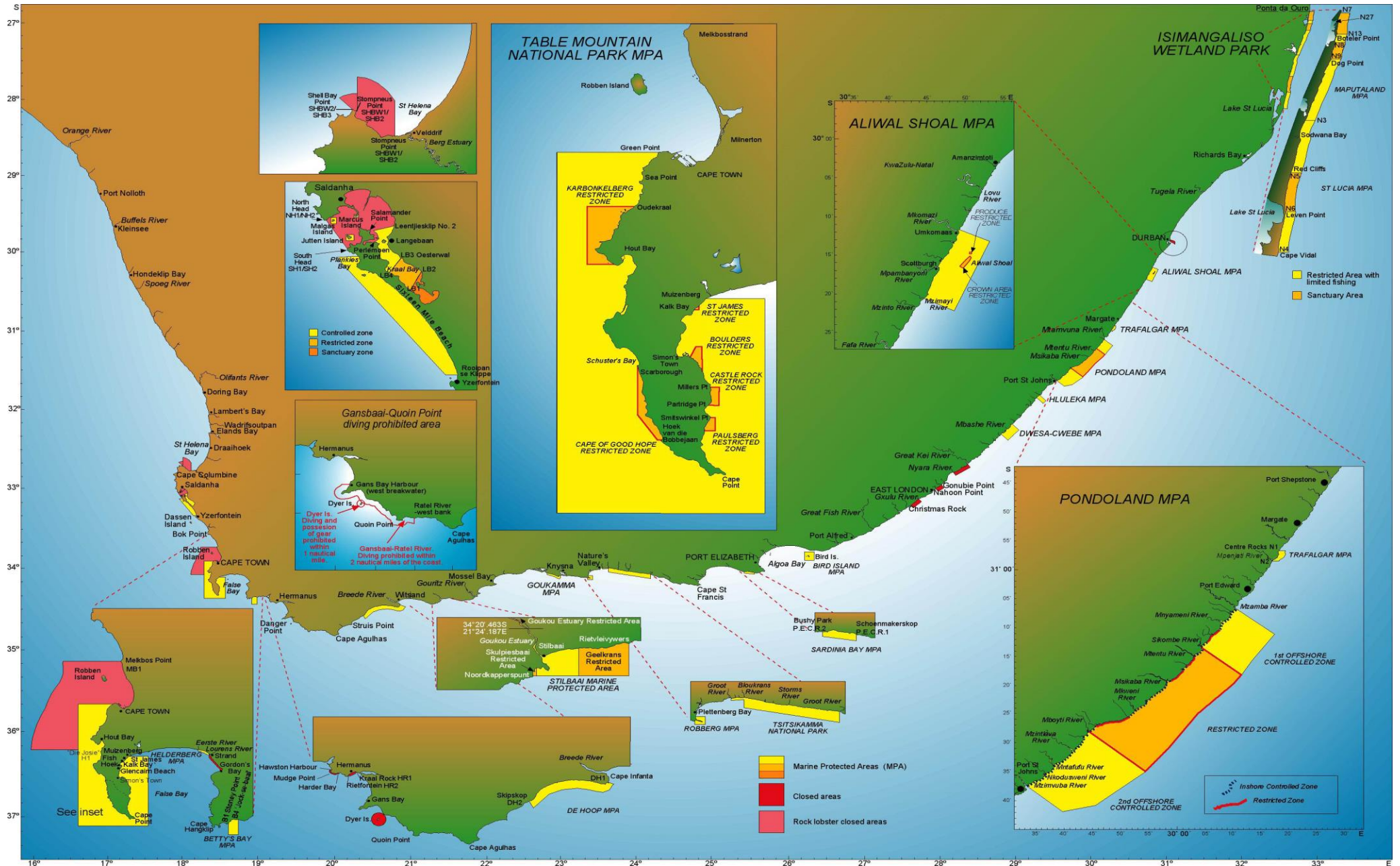


21) General MPA chart and detailed MPA's per longitude and latitudes



# LIST OF MARINE PROTECTED AREAS

## 1. TABLE MOUNTAIN NATIONAL PARK MPA

(1) The Marine Protected Area shall be divided into six restricted zones and one Controlled zone.

2. The Karbonkelberg zone shall include the area bounded by:

(a) The high-water mark between Hout Bay at position 34°03'.660 S; 018°20'.252 E and Oudekraal at position 33°58'.757 S; 018°21'.847E;

(b) a line drawn west (270°) from Hout Bay to position 34°03'.660S; 018°21'.847E;

(c) a line drawn west (270°) from Oudekraal to a position 33°58'.757S; 018°17'.797E; and

(d) a line drawn north-south joining position 34°03'.660S; 018°17'.797E and 33°58'.757S; 018°17'.797E.

(3) The Cape of Good Hope Restricted zone shall include the area bounded by:

(a) The high-water mark between Schusters Bay Point, Scarborough, at position 34°12'.271S; 018°22'.194E, and Hoek van die Bobbejaan at position 34°18'.393S; 018°24'.258E;

(b) A line drawn south (180°) from position 34°16'.490S; 018°22'.194E

(c) A line drawn south (180°) from position 34°16'.490S; 018°22'.194E; to position 34°18'.393S; 018°23'.500E; and

(d) A line drawn east (090°) from position 34°18'.393S 018°23'.500E to Hoek van die Bobbejaan.

(4) The Paulsberg Restricted zone shall include the area bounded by:

(a) The high-water mark between Venus Pool at position 34°17'.744S; 018°28'.020E and Smitwinkel Point at position 34°16'.549S; 018°28'.464E;

(b) a line drawn east (090°) from Smitwinkel Point to position 34°16'.549S; 018°29'.000E;

(c) a line drawn east (090°) from Venus Pool to position 34°17'.744S; 018°29'.000E; and

(d) a line drawn north-south joining positions 34°16'.549S; 018°29'.000E and 34°17'.744S; 018°29'.000E .

(5) The Castle Rock Restricted zone shall include the area bounded by:

(a) The high-water mark between Patridge Point at position 34°15'.480S; 018°28'.344E and Millers point at position 34°14'.100S; 018°28'.508E;

(b) A line drawn east (090°) from Millers Point to position 34°14'.100S ; 018°29'.300E;

- (c) A line drawn east (090°) from Patridge Point to position 34°15'.480S; 018°29'.300E; and
- (d) A line drawn north-south joining positions 34°14'.100S; 018°29'.300E and 34°15'.480S; 018°29'.300E.

(6) The Boulders Restricted zone shall include the area bounded by:

- (a) The high-water mark between Seafourth, Siminstown at position 34°11'.567S 018°26'.762E to position 34°12'.705S; 018°26'.762E and Rocklands, at position 34°11'.567S 018°26'.762E and Rocklands, at position 34°12'.705S; 018°27'.781E;
- (b) a line drawn from Seafourth at position 34°11'.567S; 018°26'.762E to position 34°10'.581S; 018°27'.196E;
- (c) a line drawn east (090°) from position 34°10'.581S; 018°27'.196E; to position 34°10'.581S; 018°27'.781E; and
- (d) a line drawn south (180°) from position 34°10'.581S; 018°27'.781E to Rocklands at position 34°12'.705S; 018°27'.781E.

(7) The St James Restricted zone shall include the area bounded by:

- (a) The high-water mark between the St James Tidal Pool at position 34°07'.123S; 018°27'.568E and the Kalk Bay Tidal Pool at position 34°07'.567S; 018°27'.050E;
- (b) A line drawn east (090°) from the St James Tidal Pool to position 34°07'.567S; 018°27'.568E; and
- (c) A line drawn south from position 34°07'.567S; 018°27'.568E to the Kalk Bay Tidal Pool at position 34°07'.567; 018°27'.050E.

(8) The remaining extent of the Marine Protected Area shall be a Controlled Zone.

**14. The Sixteen Mile Beach Marine Protected Area** in the Western Cape Province is the area bounded by a line beginning at the high-water mark in Piansiesbaai ( $33^{\circ}07'.106S$ ;  $017^{\circ}58'.377 E$ ), and then *running* south-eastwards along the high-water mark to Rooipan se Klippe near Yzerfontein ( $33^{\circ}20'.006S$ ,  $018^{\circ}09'.595 E$ ), and then due westwards to longitude  $018^{\circ}08'.095E$  and then along a North-west line to the intersection of latitude  $33^{\circ}07', 107S$  and longitude  $017^{\circ}55'.96E$  And then to the point of beginning.

**15. The Ma Igas Island Marine, Protected Area** in the Western Cape Province is the area below the high-water mark between latitudes  $33^{\circ}02'.806S$  and  $33^{\circ}03'.506S$  and longitudes  $017^{\circ}55'.261 E$  and  $017^{\circ}55'.862E$

**16. The Jutten Island Marine Protected Area** in the Western Cape Province is the area below the high-water mark between latitudes  $33^{\circ}04'.706S$  and  $33^{\circ}05'.306S$  and longitudes  $017^{\circ}56'.961 E$  and  $017^{\circ}57'.861 E$ .

**17. The Marcus Island Marine Protected Area** in the Western Cape Province is the area below the high-water mark between latitudes  $33^{\circ}02'.507S$  and  $33^{\circ}02'.806S$  and longitudes  $017^{\circ}57',861 E$  and  $017^{\circ}58'.361 E$ .

**18. The Helderberg Marine Protected Area** in the Western Cape Province is the area between the high-water mark and a line 500 m seawards of the high-water mark, between, as western boundary, a line due south of the mouth of the Eerste River, and, as eastern boundary, a line due south of the mouth of the Lourens River, in False Bay.

**24. THE ALI WAL SHOAL MARINE PROTECTED AREA**

The Aliwal Shoal Marine Protected Area is zoned into (2) two Restricted zones and (1) one Controlled zone.

(2) The Restricted zones comprise the Crown Area Restricted zone and the Produce Restricted zone.

(3) The Crown Area Restricted zone is enclosed by twelve points, which lie on the 25 metre isobaths. The twelve points have the following coordinates:

- (a) 30°15', 600 S; 30°49', 776 E
- (b) 30° 15', 791 S; 30°49', 714 E
- (c) 30°16', 270 S; 30°49', 627 E
- (d) 30°16', 270 S; 30°49', 409 E
- (e) 30°16', 673 S; 30°49', 078 E
- (f) 30°16', 926 S; 30°48', 835 E
- (g) 30°16', 800 S; 30°48', 600E
- (h) 30°16', 680 S; 30°48', 376E
- (i) 30°16', 189 S; 30°48', 834 E
- (j) 30°15', 908 S; 30°49', 143 E
- (k) 30°15', 518 S; 30°49', 589 E
- (l) 30°15', 474 S; 30°49', 671 E

The procedure restricted Zone is enclosed by four points, defined by the following coordinates:

- (a) 30°14',968 S; 30°49',723 E
- (b) 30°14',985 S; 30°49',846 E
- (c) 30°15',093 S; 30°49',827 E

(d) 30°15',076 S; 30°49',703 E

The controlled Zone forms the remainder of the Marine Protected Area.

## **25. THE PONDOLAND MARINE PROTECTED AREA**

### **Zonation**

(1) The Marine Protected Area shall be divided into two offshore controlled zones, one offshore Restricted zone, five inshore Controlled zones, four inshore Restricted zones, seven estuarine controlled zones, seven estuarine controlled zones and two estuarine Restricted zones.

(2) The offshore Controlled zone shall comprise that part of the Marine Protected Area, which lies to the north –east of a line running 128° from the southern head of the Sikombe River at position 31°13'.2S; 030°04'.1E to the 1000 metre isobaths at position 31°18'.S; 030°11'.6E, but which excludes estuaries and the inter-tidal zone.

3. The offshore Restricted zone shall comprise that part of the Marine Protected Area, which lies to the south-west of a line running 128° from the southern head of the Sikombe River at position 31°13'2S; 030°04'.1E to the 1000 metre isobaths at position 31°18'.2S; 030°11'.6 E, and lies to the north-east of a line running 128° from the northern head of the Mbotyi River at position 31°27'.9S 029°44'.1E to the 1000 metre isobaths at position 31°34'.7S; 029°54'.5E, but which excludes estuaries and the inter-tidal zone.

(II). The second offshore Controlled zone shall comprise that part of the Marine Protected Area, which lies to the south-west of a line running 128° from the northern head of the Mbotyi River at position 31°27'.9S; 029°44'.1E to the 1000 metre isobaths at position 31°34'.7S; 029°54'.5E, but which excludes estuaries and the inter-tidal zone.

(III). The inshore strip within the Marine Protected Area, which includes the inter-tidal zone and the immediate sub-tidal zone to a charted depth of 10 metres, but which excludes estuaries, is divided into five inshore Controlled zones and four inshore Restricted zones as described in Annexure A.

(IV). The tidal portions of the Mnyameni, Sikombe, Mkwani, Mbotyi, Mzintlava, Mntafufu and Nkodusweni Rivers are estuarine Controlled zones.

(V) The tidal portions of the Mtentu and Msikaba Rivers are estuarine restricted zones.'

### **27. THE STILLBAAI MARINE PROTECTED AREA**

- (l) There are three Restricted Zones and one Controlled Zone within the Stilbaai MPA
- (a) The Geelkrans Restricted Zone include the eastern part of the Stilbaai Marine Protected Area, adjacent to the Geelkrans Nature Reserve and Rietvlei vywers, east of the longitude 021°27'.735 S
- (b) The Skulpiesbaai Restricted Zone includes the area by a line running from Noordkapperspunt at position 34°23'.963 S; 021°24'.788 E to position 34°23'.527 S; 021°24'.970 E and along the high water mark to the point of begging at Noordkapperspunt.
- (c) The Goukou Estuarine Restricted Zone includes part of the estuary that lies between position 34°20'.463 S; 021°24'.187 E (approximately 2.3km upstream of the R323 road bridge) and position 34°17'.792 S; 021°18'.592 E (approximately 15 km upstream from the mouth); and
- (d) The remainder of the Marine protected Area is a Controlled Zone.

### **28. THE MAPUTALAND MARINE PROTECTED AREA**

In the restricted zones between beacon N13 and beacon N8 and between beacon N9 and beacon N3 shore anglers may catch fish, and skiboat anglers and spearfishers may catch certain species of pelagic fish. The greater St Lucia Wetland Park (now iSimangaliso Wetland Park).
